ORDER AMENDING DIRECTION OF ELECTION

The Labor Organization and the Municipal Employer named above having filed a stipulation with the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, requesting the Commission to conduct an election among certain employes of the above named Municipal Employer, pursuant to Section 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act; 1/ and the Commission having, on November 6, 1979, issued a Direction of Election in this matter; and said Direction of Election having not described the voting group, nor the type of election, as desired by the parties; said Direction of Election is hereby amended to read as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

DIRECTED

That an election by secret ballot shall be conducted under the direction of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission in a voting group consisting of all persons employed by Dane County in the classifications of Occupational Therapists, Physical Therapists, and Dental Health Coordinators, but excluding supervisors, craft employes, managerial and confidential employes, who were employed on November 6, 1979, except such employes as may prior to the election quit their employment or be discharged for cause, for the purpose of determining whether the required number of such employes desire to be represented by United Professionals for Quality Health Care for purposes of collective bargaining in an existing collective bargaining unit consisting of Registered Nurses, Inservice Training Nurses and Public Health Nurses.

MEMORANDUM ACCOMPANYING
ORDER AMENDING DIRECTION OF ELECTION


In accordance with the parties' stipulation to this effect, employees in the voting group described in the Direction of Election shall vote on whether to be represented by the Petitioner as part of an existing unit of professional employees consisting of persons employed by the Dane County Hospital and Home in the classifications of Registered Nurse and InService Training Nurse and all persons employed by the Dane County Department of Health in the classification of Public Health Nurse, but excluding supervisors, craft employees, managerial and confidential employees, or no representation.


If a majority vote in favor of such representation in said unit the Commission will issue an order modifying the existing bargaining unit description to reflect the inclusion of the Occupational Therapists, Physical Therapists and Dental Health Coordinators.
