MEMORANDUM ACCOMPANYING DIRECTION OF ELECTION


South West Teachers United seeks an election among the remaining professional employees who are not currently included in an existing collective bargaining unit represented by said organization. The School District has stipulated to such an election.


If the residual bargaining unit of unrepresented professionals elects to be represented by South West Teachers United, the unit involved herein shall be merged with the existing collective bargaining unit of professional employees. 2/ Terms and conditions of any existing collective bargaining agreement, however, shall not automatically be applied to employees in the residual unit unless collective bargaining produces such a result. 3/
