## ORDER TO MAKE COMPLAINT MORE DEFINITE AND CERTAIN

Drivers, Salesmen, Warehousemen, Milk Processors, Cannery, Dairy Employees and Helpers Local 695, hereafter Complainant, filed a complaint on February 25, 1980 with the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission alleging that Sauk County, hereafter Respondent, had committed violations of Chapter 111, Stats. That until said amended complaint is filed, the complaint will not be set for hearing.

## MEMORANDUM ACCOMPANYING ORDER TO MAKE COMPLAINT MORE DEFINITE AND CERTAIN

Complainant alleges that Respondent has taken certain actions such as failing to forward to Complainant dues money deducted from employes' wages, refusing to arbitrate a grievance and unilaterally discontinuing a sick leave policy. Complainant requests that the Commission take certain action to remedy the alleged actions of Respondent. Complainant, however, has not stated which section or sections of the Municipal Employment Relations Act it believes Respondent has violated by the alleged conduct. Pursuant to Wisconsin Administrative Code Section 12.02(2)(c), Complainant is required to set forth the specific statutory section or sections Respondent, by the complained of action, has allegedly violated. The Examiner has issued the accompanying order pursuant to her authority under Section 111.07(5), Stats.
