

In the Matter of the Petition of

DIRECTION OF ELECTION

South West Teachers United having filed a petition wherein it requested that the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission conduct an election, pursuant to Section 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, among certain unrepresented employees of the School District of Boscobel to determine whether said employees desire to accrete to an existing unit consisting of certain professional employees in the employ of said District; and prior to the commencement of hearing in the matter on May 1, 1980, the parties having stipulated to an election and to the employees eligible to participate therein;

DIRECTED

That an election by secret ballot shall be conducted under the direction of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission in the collective bargaining unit consisting of all regular full-time and regular part-time unorganized professional employees of the School District of Boscobel, including the school nurse, but excluding the District Administrator and all other supervisory, confidential and managerial employees, who were employed on May 22, 1980, except such employees as may prior to the election quit their employment or be discharged for cause, for the purpose of determining whether the required number of such employees desire to be represented by South West Teachers United for the purposes of collective bargaining with the School District of Boscobel.

MEMORANDUM ACCOMPANYING DIRECTION OF ELECTION


South West Teachers United seeks an election among the remaining professional employees who are not currently included in an existing collective bargaining unit represented by said organization. The School District has stipulated to such an election.


If the residual bargaining unit of unrepresented professionals elects to be represented by South West Teachers United, the unit involved herein shall be merged with the existing collective bargaining unit of professional employees. 1/ Terms and conditions of any existing collective bargaining agreement, however, shall not automatically be applied to employees in the residual unit unless collective bargaining produces such a result. 2/
