

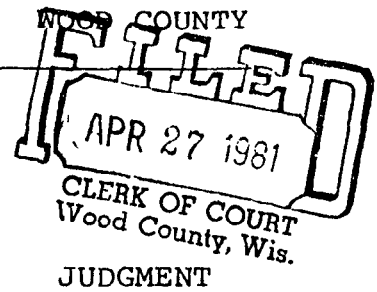

The above entitled proceeding having been commenced July 8, 1980, under secs. 111.07(8) and 111.70(4)(a)-(b), and ch. 227, Stats., to review part of a declaratory ruling of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission in Wisconsin Rapids Education Association v. Wisconsin Rapids School District, WERC Dec. No. 17877 (June 12, 1980); and


The court having reviewed the record and having had the benefit of the written and oral arguments of the parties; and
