ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Northwest United Educators, hereinafter the Complainant, having filed a complaint of prohibited practices on July 23, 1980, with the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission against Wayward Community Schools, hereinafter the Respondent; the Commission having appointed Sherwood Malamud, Examiner, to make and issue Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Orders; hearing in the matter having been scheduled for September 4, 1980; pursuant to Respondent's request hearing in the matter having been postponed to October 1, 1980; then on September 26, 1980, hearing in the matter having been postponed indefinitely pursuant to Complainant's request; and on January 26, 1981, the Examiner having issued an order which provides that said complaint would be dismissed unless a written request to set hearing in the matter were made by Complainant by February 5, 1981; the Examiner having received no written or oral request from Complainant to set hearing in the matter; and the Examiner being fully advised in the premises, makes and issues the following

ORDER

That the Complaint in the above-captioned matter be, and the same hereby is, dismissed for lack of prosecution.
