NOTICE OF COMMISSION'S FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS
OF LAW AND ORDER PURSUANT TO SECTION 111.07(5), STATS.

Examiner Peter G. Davis having, on February 2, 1981, issued his Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order, with Accompanying Memorandum, in the above-entitled proceeding, wherein the Examiner declined to exercise jurisdiction to determine whether the Respondent violated the terms of the collective bargaining agreement existing between it and the Complainant for the reason that said agreement provided for final and binding arbitration with respect to alleged violations thereof, and further wherein the Respondent was found not to have committed any prohibited practices within the meaning of the Municipal Employment Relations Act relating to an alleged refusal to bargain its decision to subcontract certain fire protection services; and no petition for review of said Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order, with Accompanying Memorandum, having been filed within the twenty day statutory period set forth in Section 111.07(5), Stats.; and no intervening order by the Examiner or the Commission having been issued within said statutory period;

NOTICE


