DIRECTION OF ELECTION

The Labor Organization and Municipal Employer named above having filed a stipulation with the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, requesting the Commission to conduct an election among certain employees of the above named Municipal Employer, pursuant to Sec. 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act; 1/

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS DIRECTED that an election by secret ballot shall be conducted under the direction of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission in the collective bargaining unit consisting of

All regular full-time and regular part-time employees of the Rock County Huber Facility, excluding confidential, supervisory, craft and professional employees, who were employed on February 12, 1981,

except such employees as may prior to the election quit their employment or be discharged for cause, for the purpose of determining whether the required number of such employees desire to be represented by the above named labor Organization for the purposes of collective bargaining with the Municipal Employer named above.


MEMORANDUM ACCOMPANYING DIRECTION OF ELECTION


Wisconsin Council of County and Municipal Employees, Local 2489, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, seeks an election among certain employees who are not currently included in an existing collective bargaining unit represented by said organization. The Municipal Employer has stipulated to such an election.


If the residual bargaining unit of unrepresented employees elects to be represented by Wisconsin Council of County and Municipal Employees, Local 2489, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, the unit involved herein shall be merged with the existing collective bargaining unit consisting of all regular full-time and regular part-time clerical employees in the Rock County Courthouse (Janesville), Rock County Airport, the Rock County Administrative Building (Beloit), the Rock County Youth Shelter Facility, the Rock County Department of Social Services (Public Welfare), the Rock County Highway Department, the Rock County Sheriff's Department, Beta Building, and all full-time and regular part-time matrons, cook-matrons, food service supervisors, and non-deputized dispatchers, but excluding all confidential, supervisory, craft, professional and all other employees of Rock County. Terms and conditions of any existing collective bargaining agreement, however, shall not automatically be applied to employees in the residual unit unless collective bargaining produces such a result. 2/
