NOTICE OF COMMISSION'S FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER PURSUANT TO SECTION 111.07(5), STATS.

Examiner Amedeo Greco having, on May 11, 1981, issued his Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order, with Accompanying Memorandum, in the above-entitled matters, wherein Technicians, Engineers & Architects of Milwaukee was found not to have committed any prohibited practices within the meaning of the Municipal Employment Relations Act; and further, wherein the City of Milwaukee was found to have committed, and was committing, a prohibited practice within the meaning of Section 111.70(3)(a)7 of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, and wherein the City of Milwaukee was ordered to cease and desist therefrom and to take certain affirmative action with respect thereto; and no petition for review of said Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order, with Accompanying Memorandum, having been filed within the twenty day statutory period set forth in Section 111.07(5), Stats.; and no intervening order by the Examiner or the Commission having been issued within said statutory period;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission issues the following

That, by operation of Section 111.07(5), Stats., Examiner Greco's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order issued in the above-entitled matters became the Commission's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order on June 1, 1981, 1/ and, therefore, the City of






