MEMORANDUM ACCOMPANYING ORDER DISMISSING
PETITION FOR DECLARATORY RULING

The Union initiated the instant declaratory ruling proceeding by filing a pleading wherein it jointly requested a declaratory ruling, and wherein it also alleged that the State had committed unfair labor practices within the meaning of the State Employment Labor Relations Act with respect to obtaining a determination by the State Personnel Board, which resulted in the State removing two employees from a unit consisting of security and public safety employees, as a result of a reclassification of said employees from Trooper 3 to Trooper 3 Confidential. The Union specifically seeks a ruling as to whether any State agency other than the Commission has jurisdiction to make such a determination.

The identical issue was involved in the complaint proceeding, and said issue was determined therein. We therefore reference the parties to said decision which has been issued today, 1/ and we find no compelling reason to issue a separate declaratory ruling in this matter.
