ORDER FURTHER AMENDING FINDINGS OF FACT

The Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission having, on November 13, 1981, issued Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Direction of Elections in the above-entitled matters and having amended such decision on November 18 and November 23, 1981; and on December 7, 1981, the Commission having been advised, in writing, that the Findings of Fact set forth in paragraph 16 of the original decision contained an errata in that said Findings indicated that the parties had agreed to exclude, as a confidential employe, the occupant of the position identified as "Secretary I - Planning" from the eligibles in Voting Group 1, but that the Conclusion of Law had indicated that said position was included in said non-professional voting group, and that, however, the Memorandum accompanying said Direction set forth that said position was excluded from said voting group as a confidential employe; and the parties having requested that the decision of the Commission be corrected to reflect that said position should be included in Voting Group 1;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

ORDERED

1. That paragraph 9 of the Findings of Fact be amended so as to indicate that the occupant of the position of Secretary I employed in the Planning Department is included in the non-professional voting group (Voting Group 1).

2. That paragraph 16 of the Findings of Fact be amended so as to exclude the position of "Secretary I - Planning" from the list of positions which the parties had previously agreed to exclude from Voting Group 1.

Nos. 19129-C 19130-C 3. That page 12 of the Memorandum accompanying the original decision be corrected to delete the position of "Secretary I - Planning" from the list of positions to be excluded from either of the voting groups involved herein.
