The above named Complainant having on February 24, 1982, filed a complaint of prohibited practices within the meaning of the Municipal Employment Relations Act with the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission; and the undersigned having on March 19, 1982 been appointed Examiner in this case; and the matter having been set for hearing on June 9, 1982; and on May 24, 1982 Complainant having filed a Motion to consolidate said complaint with complaint cases: Hewitt, et al. vs. Board Of Education for Joint School District No. 3, Hartland, Wisconsin, Case I No. 26912 MP-1161; Chetnik vs. Richfield Education Association, Case I No. 27171 MP-1176; Ekblad vs. Northwest United Educators, Case III No. 29016 MP-1284, which involve different parties and in which the undersigned has not been assigned as an Examiner for the Commission; and Counsel for Respondents Sauk Prairie Education Association, South Central United Educators and Wisconsin Education Association Council having by letter dated May 25, 1982 opposed such motion; and the Examiner being satisfied that these complaints should not be consolidated for the purposes of hearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

ORDERED

1. That the Motion to Consolidate Case XXII with the other cases set forth above is denied.
2. That the hearing on Case XXII will be held as previously scheduled on June 9, 1981 at 10:00 a.m. in the Farmers & Citizens Bank, Sauk City, Wisconsin.



MEMORANDUM ACCOMPANYING ORDER
DENYING MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE

The Complainant in Case XXII, on May 24, 1982, filed a Motion to consolidate the complaint with the complaints filed by different complainants against different respondents. The undersigned is persuaded that it would be inefficient and cumbersome to consolidate all these cases as the cases involve a large number of parties from different geographical parts of the state with different agreements. There is no showing that all the Complainants to the various cases concur with the Motion to Consolidate. Also in order to prevent undue delays in this matter and to assure full litigation of all the issues raised in each complaint the undersigned has denied the Motion to Consolidate and deems it appropriate to go forward with only Case XXII on the scheduled hearing date.
