DIRECTION OF ELECTION

The Labor Organization and the Municipal Employer named above having filed a stipulation requesting the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission to conduct an election among certain employes of the above named Municipal Employer, pursuant to Section 111.70 (4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act; 1/

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

DIRECTED

That an election by secret ballot shall be conducted under the direction of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission in the bargaining unit consisting of all employes employed as Television Production Assistants I and II by Milwaukee Area District Board of Vocational, Technical & Adult Education, excluding all managerial, supervisory and confidential employes, who were employed on February 11, 1983, except such employes as may prior to the election quit their employment or be discharged for cause, for the purpose of determining whether the required number of such employes desire to be represented by the Wisconsin Broadcast Engineers, Local Union #715, IBEW, AFL-CIO-CLC, for the purposes of collective bargaining with Milwaukee Area District Board of Vocational, Technical & Adult Education, and should the employes in said unit select said Labor Organization they will be included in a single bargaining unit with Broadcast Technicians, Engineers I, Engineers II, Television Remote Crewmen, Cinematographers and Set Designers.

MEMORANDUM ACCOMPANYING DIRECTION OF ELECTION

If the unrepresented employes in the residual bargaining unit select to be represented by Wisconsin Broadcast Engineers, Local Union #715, IBEW, AFL-CIO-CLC, they will be included in the existing collective bargaining unit represented by said organization. 2/ Terms and conditions of any existing collective bargaining agreement, however, shall not automatically be applied to employes in the residual unit unless collective bargaining produces such a result. 3/
