MEMORANDUM ACCOMPANYING DIRECTION OF ELECTION


Wisconsin Broadcast Engineers, Local Union #715, IBEW, AFL-CIO-CLC, seeks an election among certain employees who are not currently included in an existing collective bargaining unit represented by said organization. The Municipal Employer has stipulated to such an election.

If the unrepresented employees in the residual bargaining unit select to be represented by Wisconsin Broadcast Engineers, Local Union #715, IBEW, AFL-CIO-CLC, they will be included in the existing collective bargaining unit represented by said organization. 2/ Terms and conditions of any existing collective bargaining agreement, however, shall not automatically be applied to employees in the residual unit unless collective bargaining produces such a result. 3/


