The above entitled matter having been brought for hearing before this Court on October 9, 1984 at 1:45 P.M. on the Petitioner's Petition for Judicial Review pursuant to secs. 227.15, 227.16, and 227.20, Stats., and on the Respondent's Motion to Dismiss; and the parties having previously submitted briefs with respect to the matter; and the Court having heard argument with respect to said Petition and said Motion; and the Court further having determined that the Respondent's Motion should be denied and that Petitioner's Petition should be granted, and further having set forth its rationale underlying said determination on the record;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Court issues the following:

ORDER


1. That the Respondent's Motion to Dismiss filed on August 27, 1984 is hereby denied.
2. That the Petitioner's Petition for Judicial Review filed on August 10, 1984 is hereby granted.

3. That the Order of the respondent, Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission dated July 13, 1984 in Case I, No. 32213, Cw-358, Decision No. 21050-C and entitled "Kenneth A. Kraucunas, Complainant vs. Local 950, International Union of Operating Engineers, Respondent," is hereby vacated in its entirety.

4. That the case is remanded to the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission for further proceedings consistent with the Court's oral decision and this order.
