

MEMORANDUM ACCOMPANYING ORDER GRANTING
MOTION TO PERMIT TESTIMONY BY DEPOSITION

Wisconsin Administrative Code Section 10.15 provides that upon application and good cause shown, the Examiner may order the testimony of any person be taken by deposition. The Complainant has indicated that Wayne Feest is a principal witness concerning certain factual assertions which are disputed by Respondent and Mr. Feest has recently moved to Dallas, Texas having been employed by a new employer there. Mr. Feest is returning to the State of Wisconsin and is available on December 27, 1984 for the taking of his deposition. The Respondent does not take issue with these facts and does not oppose the taking of Mr. Feest's deposition. In view of the expense and inconvenience in obtaining Mr. Feest's testimony for the hearing or at a later time, the Examiner concludes that good cause has been shown for taking Mr. Feest's deposition, and therefore has granted Complainant's Motion.
