ORDER DISMISSING PETITION FOR REVIEW, SETTING ASIDE EXAMINER'S FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER, AND DISMISSING COMPLAINT

Dane County Law Enforcement Officers' Association (LEER Division of WPPA), having on April 19, 1985, filed a complaint with the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission alleging that Dane County had committed certain prohibited practices; and Examiner Christopher Honeyman having, on November 8, 1985, issued his Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order in the matter wherein he dismissed the complaint; and the Association having timely filed a petition with the Commission seeking review of the Examiner's decision; and the parties thereafter having engaged in lengthy and ultimately successful settlement efforts with the assistance of Marshall L. Gratz, a member of the Commission's staff; and the parties having executed a memorandum of agreement at a meeting convened by Gratz in Madison, Wisconsin, on January 6, 1988, which confirmed the settlement;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

ORDERED

1. That the Association's petition for review is dismissed.
2. That the Examiner's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order in the above matter are set aside.
3. That the Association's complaint is dismissed.
