ORDER SETTING ASIDE EXAMINER'S FINDINGS OF  
FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER AND DISMISSING  
COMPLAINT AND PETITION FOR REVIEW

Examiner James W. Engmann having on July 22, 1988 issued Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order with Accompanying Memorandum wherein he dismissed a complaint filed by Local 2486, AFSCME, AFL-CIO which alleged that Wood County had committed certain prohibited practices within the meaning of the Municipal Employment Relations Act; and Local 2486 having filed a timely petition with the Commission seeking review of the Examiner's decision; and the parties thereafter having engaged in an ultimately successful attempt to resolve their dispute and having advised the Commission of said settlement by letter received January 12, 1989;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

ORDERED

1. That the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order issued by Examiner James W. Engmann on July 22, 1988 are hereby set aside.

2. That the complaint and petition for review filed by Local 2486, AFSCME, AFL-CIO are hereby dismissed pursuant to the terms of the parties' settlement agreement.
