**NOTICE OF COMMISSION'S FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
AND ORDER PURSUANT TO SECTION 111.07(5), STATS.**

On January 6, 1999, Examiner David E. Shaw issued Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order, with Accompanying Memorandum, in the above-entitled matter determining that the above-named Respondent had committed prohibited practices within the meaning of Sec. 111.70(3)(b)3, Stats.
