**NOTICE OF COMMISSION'S FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

On October 9, 2003, Examiner Daniel J. Nielsen issued Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order with Accompanying Memorandum in the above-entitled matter determining that Respondent City of Oshkosh had committed prohibited practices within the meaning of Secs. 111.70(3)(a)5 and 1, Stats.
