**NOTICE OF COMMISSION'S FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
AND ORDER PURSUANT TO SECTION 111.07(5), STATS.**

On February 23, 2006, Examiner David E. Shaw issued Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order with Accompanying Memorandum, in the above-entitled matter determining that Respondent had committed prohibited practices within the meaning of Secs. 111.84(1)(d), Stats. He ordered Respondent to take certain remedial action.

The Examiner further concluded that Respondent had not committed other alleged unfair labor practices within the meaning of Secs. 111.84(1)(d) and (e), Stats.
