CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-entitled matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission on December 4, 2014, conducted an election pursuant to Sec. 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the above Municipal Employer, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the above-named Labor Organization for the purposes of collective bargaining with the Municipal Employer.

The result of the election was as follows:

1.	Total number eligible to vote	161
2.	Total ballots cast	87
3.	Total valid ballots counted	86
4.	Ballots cast for Marinette Education Association	85
5.	Ballots cast for no representation	1

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by Sec. 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that Marinette Education Association has been selected by a majority of the voting employees who voted at said election in the collective bargaining unit

consisting of all regular full-time and regular part-time professional employees of the Marinette School District, excluding substitute teachers, supervisors, confidential, managerial and executive employees, as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of Sec. 111.70 of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, said Labor Organization is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purposes of collective bargaining with the above named Municipal Employer.
