ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR REHEARING

On April 4, 2019, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission issued and served a Decision on Petition for Review in the above-captioned matter dismissing the complaint for lack of jurisdiction. On April 30, 2019, Slamka filed a petition for rehearing pursuant to § 227.49, Stats. Sheet Metal Workers Union Local No. 18 filed a statement in opposition to the petition on May 20, 2019. The Commission has considered the matter and concluded that the April 30, 2019 petition is untimely because it was not filed within the statutorily required 20 days after service of the April 4, 2019 decision (*see* § 227.49, Stats.).
