DIRECTION OF NEW ELECTION

Pursuant to a January 29, 2019 Request for Annual Certification Election, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission having, on April 3, 2019, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d)3.b., Stats., to determine if certain employees in the Department of Public Works bargaining unit of the Village of Orfordville wanted to continue to be represented by the Teamsters Union Local No. 695 for the purposes of collective bargaining; and the election tally sheet having advised the parties that none of the three eligible voters had voted; and a timely objection to the election results having been filed by the Village asserting the election notices had not been distributed or posted in the workplace and asking that a new election be conducted; and Teamsters having agreed that said notices were not distributed or posted and joined in the request for a new election; and the Commission having considered the matter and concluded that a new election should be conducted;


NOW, THEREFORE, it is

DIRECTED

That a new election shall be conducted by mail ballot under the direction of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission among all employees in the Department of Public Works bargaining unit, who were employed on January 29, 2019, except such employees¹ as may prior to the election leave or be removed from the bargaining unit, for the purpose of determining whether at least fifty-one percent (51%) of the employees in the bargaining unit want to continue to be represented by the Teamsters Union Local No. 695 for the purposes of collective bargaining with the Village of Orfordville.
