CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on December 12, 2019, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the Peshtigo School District, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the Peshtigo Education Association, WEAC Region 3, for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Peshtigo School District.

The result of the election was as follows:

1.	Total number eligible to vote	92
2.	Total ballots cast	65
3.	Total valid ballots counted	65
4.	Ballots cast for Peshtigo Education Association, WEAC Region 3	61
5.	Ballots cast for no representation	4

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Peshtigo Education Association, WEAC Region 3 has been selected by at least fifty-one percent (51%) of all eligible employees in the collective

bargaining unit consisting of all regular full-time and regular part-time classroom teachers, librarians, guidance counselors, psychologist, nurse, reading coordinator or specialist, employed by the Peshtigo School District, excluding all supervisory, managerial, and confidential employees, as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act said Labor Organization is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Peshtigo School District.
