CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on November 18, 2019, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the Butternut School District, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the Butternut Federation of Teachers, AFT Local 3371, AFL-CIO, for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Butternut School District.

The result of the election was as follows:

1.	Total number eligible to vote	25
2.	Total ballots cast	19
3.	Total valid ballots counted	19
4.	Ballots cast for Butternut Federation of Teachers, AFT Local 3371, AFL-CIO	18
5.	Ballots cast for no representation	1

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Butternut Federation of Teachers, AFT Local 3371, AFL-CIO, has been selected by at least fifty-one percent (51%) of all eligible employees in the collective bargaining unit consisting of all regular full-time and regular part-time teachers excluding confidential, managerial and supervisory employees, as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act said Labor Organization is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Butternut School District.
