CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on December 17, 2019, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of Iowa County, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by either the Wisconsin Professional Police Association or by Teamsters Union Local 695, or by neither of said Labor Organizations, for the purpose of collective bargaining with Iowa County.

The result of the election was as follows:

1.	Total number eligible to vote	33
2.	Total ballots cast	27
3.	Total valid ballots counted	27
4.	Ballots cast for Wisconsin Professional Police Association	22
5.	Ballots cast for Teamsters Union Local 695	4
6.	Ballots cast for no representation	1

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Wisconsin Professional Police Association has been selected by a majority of all eligible employees who voted at said election in the collective bargaining unit consisting of all deputized employees of the Iowa County Sheriff's Department,

including correctional officer/dispatchers, patrol officers, detectives, sergeants, excluding the sheriff, deputy sheriff, supervisory, managerial, and confidential employees, as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act the Wisconsin Professional Police Association is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with Iowa County.
