CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on February 11, 2020, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the Gillett School District, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the Gillett Education Association, WEAC Region 3, for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Gillett School District.

The result of the election was as follows:

1.	Total number eligible to vote	54
2.	Total ballots cast	48
3.	Total valid ballots counted	48
4.	Ballots cast for Gillett Education Association, WEAC Region 3,	47
5.	Ballots cast for no representation	1

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Gillett Education Association, WEAC Region 3 has been selected by at least fifty-one percent (51%) of all eligible employees in the collective

bargaining unit consisting of all regular full-time and regular part-time contracted teachers, excluding CESA personnel, teacher-administrators, substitutes, supervisory, managerial, or confidential employees with the Gillett School Board, as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act said Labor Organization is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Gillett School District.
