## **DIRECTION OF ELECTION**

The Gillett Education Association, WEAC Region 3, hereinafter referred to as the Labor Organization, on September 6, 2019, filed a petition with the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission requesting the Commission to conduct an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, among certain employees of the Gillett School District, to determine whether such employees desire to be represented by said Labor Organization for the purpose of collective bargaining; and prior to a hearing by the Commission, the Gillett School District and the Labor Organization having executed a Stipulation for Election; and the Commission being satisfied that a question has arisen concerning representation of certain employees of Gillett School District;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

## **DIRECTED**

That an election by secret ballot shall be conducted under the direction of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission within forty-five (45) days from the date of this directive in the collective bargaining unit consisting of all regular full-time and regular part-time contracted teachers, excluding CESA personnel, teacher-administrators, substitutes, supervisory, managerial, or confidential employees with the Gillett School Board, who were employed on January 15, 2020, except such employees as may prior to the election leave or be removed from the bargaining unit, for the purpose of determining whether at least fifty-one percent (51%) of all eligible employees vote to be represented by the Labor Organization, for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Gillett School District, or whether such employees vote not to be so represented by said Labor Organization.
