**CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE**

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on April 6, 2020, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the Brodhead Water & Light Commission, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the IBEW Local 2150 for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Brodhead Water & Light Commission.

The result of the election was as follows:

1.	Voting Group 1 – Ballots cast for Representation	2
2.	Voting Group 1 – Ballots cast for No Representation	0
3.	Voting Group 2 – Ballots cast for Representation	4
4.	Voting Group 2 – Ballots cast for No Representation	0
5.	Voting Group 2 -Ballots cast to be included in bargaining unit with non-craft employees	4
6.	Voting Group 2 – Ballots cast <u>not</u> to be included in bargaining unit with non-craft employees	0

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the IBEW Local 2150 has been selected by at least fifty-one percent (51%) of all eligible employees in the collective bargaining unit consisting of all regular full-time and regular part-time employees of the Brodhead Water and Light Commission including craft employees and excluding supervisors and confidential, managerial and executive employees, as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act said Labor Organization is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Brodhead Water & Light Commission.
