**DIRECTION OF NEW ELECTION**

Pursuant to a January 13, 2020 Request for Annual Certification Election, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission having on April 21, 2020, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d)3.b., Wis. Stats. to determine if certain employees in the Department of Public Works unit of the Village of Boyd wanted to continue to be represented by the General Teamsters Union Local No. 662 for the purposes of collective bargaining; and a timely objection to election results having been filed by the General Teamsters Union Local No. 662 asserting that employees did not receive sufficient notice of the election and requesting that a new election be conducted; and the Village having advised that it did not object to the conduct of a new election; and the Commission having considered the matter and concluded that a new election should be conducted;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

**DIRECTED**

That a new election shall be conducted by mail ballot under the direction of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission among all employees in the Department of Public Works unit, who were employed on January 13, 2020, except such employees as may prior to the election leave or be removed from the bargaining unit, for the purpose of determining whether at least fifty-one percent (51%) of the employees in the bargaining unit want to continue to be represented by General Teamsters Union Local No. 662 for the purpose of collective bargaining with Village of Boyd.
