**DIRECTION OF NEW ELECTION**

Pursuant to a January 27, 2020 Request for Annual Certification Election, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission having on April 21, 2020, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d)3.b., Wis. Stats. to determine if certain employees in the nurses unit of Milwaukee County wanted to continue to be represented by AFT-Wisconsin Federation of Nurses and Health Professionals, Local 5000, AFL-CIO for the purposes of collective bargaining; and a timely objection to election results having been filed asserting that employees did not receive sufficient notice of the election and requesting that a new election be conducted; and the County having advised that it did not object to the conduct of a new election; and the Commission having considered the matter and concluded that a new election should be conducted;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

**DIRECTED**

That a new election shall be conducted by mail ballot under the direction of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission among all employees in the nurses unit, who were employed on January 27, 2020, except such employees as may prior to the election leave or be removed from the bargaining unit, for the purpose of determining whether at least fifty-one percent (51%) of the employees in the bargaining unit want to continue to be represented by AFT-Wisconsin Federation of Nurses and Health Professionals, Local 5000, AFL-CIO, for the purpose of collective bargaining with Milwaukee County.
