# **CERTIFICATION OF ELECTION RESULTS**

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on April 28, 2020, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the Colby School District, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the Colby Education Association, WEAC Region 2, for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Colby School District.
