DIRECTION OF NEW ELECTION

The Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, having on June 25, 2020 issued a Certification of Election Results in this matter reflecting that neither the Wisconsin Professional Police Association nor the General Teamsters Union Local No. 662 had been selected by a majority of the eligible voters to be the collective bargaining representative of certain public safety employees of Clark County; and both labor organizations having requested that a run-off election be conducted; and the Commission being satisfied that a run-off election is appropriate;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

DIRECTED

That a new election shall be conducted by mail ballot under the direction of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission among all employees in the collective bargaining unit consisting of all regular full-time and regular part-time employees assigned as road deputy, recreational patrol, sergeants and detective/investigators with the power of arrest in the Clark County Sheriff's Department, excluding the Sheriff, Chief Deputy, supervisors, managers, and confidential employees, who were employed on June 29, 2020, except such employees as may prior to the election leave or be removed from the bargaining unit, for the purpose of determining whether a majority of the voting employees vote to be represented by the Wisconsin Professional Police Association or General Teamsters Union Local No. 662, for the purpose of collective bargaining with Clark County, or whether such employees vote not to be so represented by either Labor Organization.
