### **CERTIFICATION OF ELECTION RESULTS**

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on August 24, 2020, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the Mid-State Technical College, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the Mid-State Technical College Faculty Association-WEAC R2, for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Mid-State Technical College. Objections to the election were filed by the Union on August 31, 2020, corrected on September 1, 2020, and then withdrawn on September 30, 2020.

#### The result of the election was as follows:

1.	Total number eligible to vote	/6
2.	Total ballots cast	52
3.	Total valid ballots counted	52
4.	Ballots cast for Mid-State Technical College Faculty Association-WEAC R2	34
5.	Ballots cast for no representation	18

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that at least fifty-one percent (51%) of all eligible employees in the collective bargaining unit failed to select Mid-State Technical College Faculty Association-WEAC R2 as their bargaining representative.
