**CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE**

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on October 16, 2020, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the Village of Sussex, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the Pewaukee Fire Fighters Local 5241 for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Village of Sussex.

The result of the election was as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Pewaukee Fire Fighters Local 5241, has been selected by a majority of all eligible employees who voted at said election in the collective



bargaining unit consisting of: All full-time professional employees whose primary function includes but is not limited to fire fighting, fire prevention, and emergency medical services, excluding chief officers, supervisors, and confidential, managerial and executive employees., as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act the Pewaukee Fire Fighters Local 5241 is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Village of Sussex.
