DIRECTION OF NEW ELECTION

Pursuant to a September 11, 2020 Request for Annual Certification Election, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission having on November 24, 2020, conducted an election pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine if the employees in the Teacher unit of the Ripon Area School District wanted to continue to be represented by the Ripon Education Association, WEAC Region 5, for the purposes of collective bargaining; and a timely objection to the election results having been filed asserting that employees did not receive sufficient notice of the election and requesting that a new election be conducted; and the District having advised that it did not object to the conduct of a new election; and the Commission having considered the matter and concluded that a new election should be conducted;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

DIRECTED

That a new election shall be conducted by secret mail ballot under the direction of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission among all employees in the Teacher unit who were employed on September 11, 2020, except such employees as may prior to the election leave or be removed from the bargaining unit, for the purpose of determining whether at least fifty-one percent (51%) of the employees in the bargaining unit want to continue to be represented by the Ripon Education Association, WEAC Region 5, for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Ripon Area School District.
