CERTIFICATION OF RESULTS OF ELECTION

Pursuant to a Direction of New Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on January 25, 2021, conducted an election pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d)3.b. of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the Ripon Area School District, in the Teacher collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, wanted to continue to be represented by the Ripon Education Association, WEAC Region 5, for the purposes of collective bargaining with the Ripon Area School District.

The result of the election was as follows:

1.	Total number eligible to vote	138
2.	Total ballots cast	109
3.	Total valid ballots counted	105
4.	Ballots cast for Ripon Education Association, WEAC Region 5,	101
5.	Ballots cast for no representation	4

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d)3.b. of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that least fifty-one percent (51%) of the employees in the Teacher bargaining unit voted to be represented by Ripon Education Association, WEAC Region 5 for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Ripon Area School District.
