CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on February 1, 2021, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the Milwaukee Area Technical College, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the AFT Local 212, AFL-CIO for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Milwaukee Area Technical College.

The result of the election was as follows:

1.	Total number eligible to vote	21
2.	Total ballots cast	18
3.	Total valid ballots counted	18
4.	Ballots cast for AFT Local 212, AFL-CIO	16
5.	Ballots cast for no representation	2

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the AFT Local 212, AFL-CIO has been selected by at least fifty-one percent (51%) of all eligible employees in the collective bargaining unit consisting

of all regular full-time and regular part-time television engineers, television production specialists and television set designers/constructors; excluding all employees covered under other bargaining unit agreements, clerical employees, guards and all supervisory, managerial and confidential employees, as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act said Labor Organization is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Milwaukee Area Technical College.
