CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on March 4, 2021, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the City of Green Bay, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the City of Green Bay Parks and Forestry Labor Association, for the purpose of collective bargaining with the City of Green Bay.

The result of the election was as follows:

1.	Total number eligible to vote	60
2.	Total ballots cast	41
3.	Total valid ballots counted	41
4.	Ballots cast for City of Green Bay Parks and Forestry Labor Assoc, 39	
5.	Ballots cast for no representation	2

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the City of Green Bay Parks and Forestry Labor Association has been selected by at least fifty-one percent (51%) of all eligible employees in the collective bargaining unit consisting of all regular full-time and regular part-time employees of the Parks, Recreation and Forestry Department, excluding all supervisory, managerial, and confidential employees, as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act said Labor Organization is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with the City of Green Bay.
