IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Rosendale-Brandon Education Association, WEAC Region 5 has been selected by at least fifty-one percent (51%) of all eligible employees in the collective bargaining unit consisting of all regular full-time and regular part-time certified teaching staff of the Rosendale-Brandon School District, excluding managerial, confidential, and supervisory employees as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act said Labor Organization is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Rosendale-Brandon School District.
