DIRECTION OF NEW ELECTION

Pursuant to a January 21, 2021 Request for Annual Certification Election, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission having on April 27, 2021, conducted an election pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine if the employees in the Craft unit of Dane County wanted to continue to be represented by the Building and Construction Trades Council of South Central Wisconsin, for the purposes of collective bargaining; and a timely objection to the election results having been filed asserting that employees did not receive sufficient notice of the election and requesting that a new election be conducted; and Dane County having advised that it did not object to the conduct of a new election; and the Commission having considered the matter and concluded that a new election should be conducted;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

DIRECTED

That a new election shall be conducted by secret mail ballot under the direction of the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission among all employees in the Craft unit who were employed on January 21, 2021, except such employees as may prior to the election leave or be removed from the bargaining unit, for the purpose of determining whether at least fifty-one percent (51%) of the employees in the bargaining unit want to continue to be represented by the Building and Construction Trades Council of South Central Wisconsin, for the purpose of collective bargaining with Dane County.
