## **CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE**

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on September 23, 2021, conducted an election pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the City of Chetek, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to continue to be represented by the Wisconsin Professional Police Association, or desired to be represented by the Chetek Police Officer's Association, or by neither of said Labor Organizations for the purpose of collective bargaining with the City of Chetek.

The result of the election was as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Chetek Police Officer's Association has been selected by a majority of all eligible employees who voted at said election in the collective bargaining unit consisting of all regular full-time and regular part-time law enforcement employees with the powers of arrest for the City of Chetek, excluding the Chief of Police, Lieutenant, managerial, confidential, and supervisory employees as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act the Chetek Police Officer's Association is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with the City of Chetek.
