**CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE**

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on August 10, 2021, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the City of Greenfield, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the Greenfield Police Association for the purpose of collective bargaining with the City of Greenfield.

The result of the election was as follows:

1.	Total number eligible to vote	48
2.	Total ballots cast	38
3.	Total valid ballots counted	38
4.	Ballots cast for Greenfield Police Association,	37
5.	Ballots cast for no representation	1

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Greenfield Police Association has been selected by a majority of all eligible employees who voted at said election in the collective bargaining unit

consisting of all regular full-time and part-time law enforcement personnel with the powers of arrest for the City of Greenfield, excluding the chief, captains, lieutenants, sergeants, managerial, confidential, and supervisory employees as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act the Greenfield Police Association, is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with the City of Greenfield.
