CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on August 31, 2021, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of Pierce County, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to continue to be represented by The Labor Association of Wisconsin, Inc. or desired to be represented by the Wisconsin Professional Police Association, for the purpose of collective bargaining with Pierce County.

The result of the election was as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Wisconsin Professional Police Association, has been selected by a majority of all eligible employees who voted at said election in the collective bargaining unit consisting of all regular full-time employees employed by the Pierce County Sheriff's Department in the positions of sergeant/jailer deputy, jailer deputy, jailer, and secretary/deputy/jailer, excluding supervisors and confidential, managerial and executive employees and general municipal employees, as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act the Wisconsin Professional Police Association, is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with Pierce County.
