**CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE**

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on October 4, 2021, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.83(1) of the State Employment Labor Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the State of Wisconsin, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the Wisconsin State Attorneys Association, for the purpose of collective bargaining with the State of Wisconsin.

The result of the election was as follows:

1.	Total number eligible to vote	257
2.	Total ballots cast	150
3.	Total valid ballots counted	150
4.	Ballots cast for Wisconsin State Attorneys Association	144
5.	Ballots cast for no representation	6

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.83(1) of the State Employment Labor Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Wisconsin State Attorneys Association, has been selected by a majority of all eligible employees who voted at said election in the collective bargaining unit consisting of Employees classified as attorneys and as assistant attorneys general

by the State of Wisconsin as defined by WERC Certification Case XXXIII No. 16403 SE-65, Dec. No. 11640 (WERC, 03/1973), as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.83(1) of the State Employment Labor Relations Act said Labor Organization is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with the State of Wisconsin.
