IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Wisconsin Professional Police Association has been selected by a majority of all eligible employees who voted in the collective bargaining unit consisting of sworn police officers with the power to arrest including sergeant, K9 handler, officers; excluding confidential employees and Chief of Police, as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act said Labor Organization is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with the City of Mondovi.
