CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on September 22, 2022, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the Village of West Milwaukee, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the Wisconsin Professional Police Association or by the West Milwaukee Professional Police Association or by neither of said Labor Organizations for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Village of West Milwaukee.

The result of the election was as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the West Milwaukee Professional Police Association has been selected by a majority of all eligible employees who voted in the collective bargaining unit consisting of Corporal of Police, Detective of Police and Patrol Officer, but excluding Chief of Police, Captain of Police, Lieutenant of Police and all other supervisory, managerial, executive, confidential employees, and other employees, as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act said Labor Organization is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Village of West Milwaukee.
