**CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE**

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on March 16, 2023, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the Village of Footville, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the General Teamsters Union Local No. 695, for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Village of Footville.

The result of the election was as follows:

1.	Total number eligible to vote	4
2.	Total ballots cast	4
3.	Total valid ballots counted	4
4.	Ballots cast for General Teamsters Union Local No. 695	4
5.	Ballots cast for no representation	0

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the General Teamsters Union Local No. 695 has been selected by at least fifty-one percent (51%) of all eligible employees in the collective bargaining

unit consisting of all regular full-time and regular part-time employees of the Water Department, including clerical employees, but excluding supervisory, managerial, and confidential employees, as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act said Labor Organization is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Village of Footville.
