CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE

Pursuant to a Direction of Election previously issued by it in the above-captioned matter, the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission, on April 3, 2023, conducted an election, pursuant to § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act, to determine whether employees of the Mount Horeb Area Joint Fire Department, in the collective bargaining unit set forth in the Commission's Direction, desired to be represented by the International Association of Fire Fighters, Local 311, for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Mount Horeb Area Joint Fire Department.

The result of the election was as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of and pursuant to the power vested in the Wisconsin Employment Relations Commission by § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act;

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the IAFF Local 311, has been selected by a majority of all eligible employees who voted at said election in the collective bargaining unit consisting of Bargaining Unit consist of all regular full-time EMT/Firefighters of the Mount Horeb Area Joint Fire Department, excluding confidential, supervisory ranks (Captain to Chief of the Department), managerial, craft, and law enforcement employees, as their representative; and that pursuant to the provisions of § 111.70(4)(d) of the Municipal Employment Relations Act the IAFF Local 311, is the exclusive collective bargaining representative of all such employees for the purpose of collective bargaining with the Mount Horeb Area Joint Fire Department.
